2. A Teacher OR another adult who knows you and your abilities well (e.g., employer, coach, advisor, etc.) – Please note: this person may not be a relative or WCC member.
Letters of recommendation must be submitted directly by the individual providing the reference via email (womansclubofconcord@gmail.com) with the Subject Line: "WCC Letter of Recommendation for [INSERT APPLICANTS NAME]"
Applications will be reviewed by the WCC Scholarship Committee. Finalists will be selected and may be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee by mid-April. The strongest candidate(s) will be selected and notified before May 1st. A Scholarship Award Certificate will be presented to the recipient(s) at the Woman's Club of Concord Annual Meeting in May.
